- We understand that all attendees must follow all pool rules and regulations.
- We understand that no lifeguards will be on duty and it is a swim at your own risk.
- We understand that there is to be no food, gum, or glass in the pool area. All food must remain in the snack area.
- We understand that glass containers are strictly prohibited at the pool.
- We understand that the pool staff will reserve tables in the snack area for our party but we are responsible for our own clean-up. Trash cans are provided.

For party attendees under the age of 15, we suggest 1 adult per 4 attendees.

I acknowledge that my legal dependants listed below have voluntarily chosen to swim at the Walnut Valley Homesowners Association's swimming pool. I understand that swimming involves risk of harm. I am aware of the risks and dangers inherent with swimming and I knowingly and willingly assume risk of injury, including death, whether obvious or not obvious. In consideration of and as a part payment for the right to use WVHA's swimming pool and related facilities, I agree that all individuals listed on this release are fully capable of safely participating in swimming activities. As lawful consideration for being permitted by the WVHA to use their swimming pool and related facilities, I agree to defend, indemnify, hold harmless, not to sue, and to release from any legal liability the WVHA, and all of their officers, members, organization, agents, and employees for any and all injury or death to me or my dependents caused by or resulting from my/our participation in the use of the swimming pool and related facilities provided by the WVHA, whether or not such injury or death was caused by or resulting from their negligence or any other cause. I state that I am the legal guardian of the children listed on this application. I am aware that I am releasing certain legal rights that I/my dependents may have, and I execute this release on behalf of myself and my dependents of my own freewill. I acknowledge that I have read, understood, and will comply with the pool use Guidelines which are incorporated herein by reference.

Pool Guidelines

1. Pool Committee personnel control ALL areas of the pool, including eating areas and restrooms. Safety rules are posted at the pool and must be obeyed. No lifeguards are on duty. Pool Committee members have the authority to remove anyone from the pool area for violation of these rules or any conduct that could affect the safety of others. If you disagree with a decision you may contact the Walnut Valley Homes Association President or Vice President.
2. The baby pool is for children 5 and under only. Appropriate childcare workers are responsible for children under their care while in the baby pool. CHILDREN WHO ARE NOT POTTY TRAINED MUST WEAR AN APPROVED SWIM DIAPER. DIAPER CHANGES ARE TO BE DONE IN THE RESTROOMS – NOT POOLSIDE.
3. Members must use code given to enter the pool area. (Pool member is to not provide their code to pool party attendees. They must open the gate for guests.)
4. Children under age 15 must be accompanied by an adult.
5. No running, rough play, or diving in shallow areas.
6. No glass containers in the pool area.
7. Proper swim attire is required.
8. Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times.
9. No pets in the pool area.
10. Respect each other and clean up after yourselves.
11. Follow all other/additional rules listed at the pool
12. All rules are subject to change. Any changes will be posted in the pool area or on the Walnut Valley Homes Association website (walnutvalley.org)
13. Sharing of access code with anyone outside of listed members of the household shall result in revocation of membership without refund.
